 SUBJECT: ICAPS Agenda

DATE: 4 March 1947

The following are the outstanding subjects on ICAPS agenda at the present time:

1. Intelligence Terminology. Arrangements have been made to meet weekly with JIS to determine definitions on CIG's list of intelligence terms used loosely. JIS-CIG agreements will be circulated to the IAB for concurrence. A professional lexicographer at the Library or Congress has been made available in a consultative capacity.
2. Coordination of Foreign Port Data. Implementation plan completed, awaiting front office concurrence.
3. National Intelligence Requirements. Requests for agency statements of agency requirements have been circulated for the: (a) Korea; (b) USSR; (c) Middle East. Ambiguity of the term "Middle East" has resulted in breaking this NIR into three sections: 1. Turkey and Greece; 2. Arab States; 3. Iran.
4. Foreign Industrial Establishments. Committee paper in process of completion but has been so emasculated that ICAPS currently contemplates holding it pending IAB decision on the production plan.
5. Plan for the Coordination of Intelligence Production. The ad hoc committee has submitted the final comments on the last draft. ICAPS is in the process of integrating these proposals for submission to IAB.
6. Guided Missiles. The program for intelligence on guided missiles is again before the agencies for comment.
7. Hoover Library. CIG is still awaiting War Department concurrence in the proposal to screen new material arriving from the Far East at Palo Alto rather than Washington.
8. Liaison With Other Than IAB Agencies. Liaison has been established with almost all agencies of the Government for possible emergency or other special use. ICAPS maintains a register setting forth the security status of these contacts for use by CIG generally.
9. Exploitation of Foreign Nationals. A special IAB paper is being prepared to extend the activities of the Contact Branch in this field.
