SUBJECT: Weekly Activity Report - Week ending September 27, 1946.

23,24,25 September 1946: Nothing to report. (Complied with AAF Flying Regulations.)

26 September 1946:

1. Discussed with Personnel Officer (Lightsey) assignment and transfer of [REDACTED] from State Department to CIG-ORE. Lightsey is in liaison with Mr. Huddle and awaiting reception of job descriptions and personal histories.

2. Informed Major Walsh (Hq. AAF-A-2, Ext. 6548) that memorandum of General Samford suggesting CIG assistance in atomic intelligence was in process. Manhattan District was being requested to report on feasibility as a result of Baker Tests. Further, we are awaiting clarification of relationship with Atomic Energy Commission.

3. Attended meeting of SWNCC ad hoc committee on Psychological Warfare. Wartime organization in the Government was discussed. Next meeting Thursday, 3 October 1946 - 1430, Room 159 State Department.
