2. Geographic Intelligence. Initiated by [Redacted] Transfer of [Redacted] and four assistants to OR&E has been approved in principle. [Redacted] (P&A) is arranging for transfer of positions and interviews between [Redacted] and assistants. Upon transfer, Geographic Division will be activated in Functional Branch, OR&E.

3. Military Attache Conference, Manila, 21 October 1946. Under guidance of G-2, military attaches and air attaches to attend with Washington representatives of G-2 and ONI. Office, C&D recommends no attendance by CIG. General Vandenberg has stated desire for two CIG representatives to attend. [Redacted] has requested informally an invitation from G-2.

4. ICAPS Program for Coordination of Intelligence Activities. List of projects for ICAPS coordination has been compiled and submitted to OSO, OR&E, OC&D and P&A for comment (18 September 1946).

5. Personnel. Informal talks with OR&E resulted in rejection of Lt. Colonel Casey, AAF nomination for Plans and Requirements Branch, OR&E, on grounds of insufficient experience. AAF has been informed.

6. Air War College request for instructional data. Reply to AC/AS has been prepared. Now awaiting reproduction of 50-minute speech by Advisory Council.
