FROM : Captain  25X1ASUBJECT: Summary of Activities and Accomplishments of Past Two Weeks
(No report submitted last Monday)

1. Washington Document Center. Letters to Secretary of War and Secretary of Navy sent out 4 November, 1946 from CIG. No official replies as yet. Captain Murphy stated Bu Pers found it difficult to raise CIG personnel ceilings and suggested alternately that naval officers and men retained in service until 1 July, 1947 be discharged now so as to permit their employment by CIG as civilians. Preliminary steps along these lines are being taken.

2. Industrial College Economic Studies. Answered their letter to effect that CIG would provide economic studies when able to do so. Recommended they go direct to agencies in meanwhile.

3. Liaison Contacts with Agencies. Wrote rough drafts of two Operations Memos for liaisons of C&D and ORE. Will write preliminary memos to agencies requesting their prior approval.

4. Intelligence Terminology. Awaiting answers from ORE and SO to our memo requesting their lists of intelligence terms loosely used. C&D has answered.
