25X1A 1. Washington Document Center. At meeting held 8 October Mr. [REDACTED] arranged for G-2 and ONI to submit rosters of personnel who would actually be turned over to CIG. These were received subsequently by [REDACTED], who with [REDACTED] will be responsible for WDC, when he visited WDC. The formal acceptance will be delayed until it is assured that personnel ceilings will be raised to provide for additional personnel.

2. Deputy Assistant Director for R&E. [REDACTED] has not yet returned from China due apparently to delay in reporting of his relief.

3. SWNCC Security Advisory Board. No progress. CIG still awaits invitation from SWNCC. [REDACTED] reports State & Navy willing, but some complications from War.

4. I.L.O. Intelligence Reports. Meetings arranged with Mr. Morse, Assistant Secretary of Labor for 15 October.

5. Establishment of ORE's Scientific Branch. Exploratory talks with ONI. Crystallization of their opinion on subject requested.

6. Bilateral agreements with ONI. Unenthusiastic reception to idea from Captain Davis.
