

7. Some overall interdepartmental coordination and liaison is desirable, in addition to that performed on the operational level, and some overall planning, and some representation on committees, at least in the initial stages of a project or when a subject under discussion is of especial interest to CIA. We think that all of this can be done with a much smaller personnel in ICAPS and that the balance of the ICAPS personnel can be more advantageously used elsewhere in CIA.

8. This memo refers only to ICAPS as presently constituted and only to the work now allotted to ICAPS. Whether or not additional duties should be given to ICAPS or the former survey and inspection work restored to ICAPS are matters which I think are within the purview of the Directorate.
