SUBJECT: On-the-spot Survey, Agriculture Research Center, Beltsville, Maryland

1. The Agricultural Research Administration at Beltsville, Maryland, has prepared a one-day program to be given on Friday, 28 April, for Department of State analysts who are officially concerned with this field. ORE will be permitted to send a limited number of persons who are similarly concerned.

2. The program includes a film showing research work with corn in North Carolina and a series of talks on such subjects as:

New Uses for Farm Products
Cotton for Fiber, Feed and Food
Grassland Agriculture
Farm Machinery Research
Development of Livestock for Specific Purposes
Solving Problems of the Poultry Industry

3. Transportation will be free, by chartered bus, but no per diem or expense allowance will be paid. The bus loads in front of State Annex #1 (23rd and E Streets, N. W.) at 0730, leaves at 0745, and departs from Beltsville at 1630 for return to Washington.

4. ORE component chiefs are requested to telephone the names of nominees to attend this program to [redacted] by 1500, Friday, 21 April. Reports are not desired from those who have no nominees. Component chiefs will be notified on Monday, 24 April, which of their nominees are approved for the trip, as it may not be possible to accommodate all who wish to attend.
