* chiefs. *

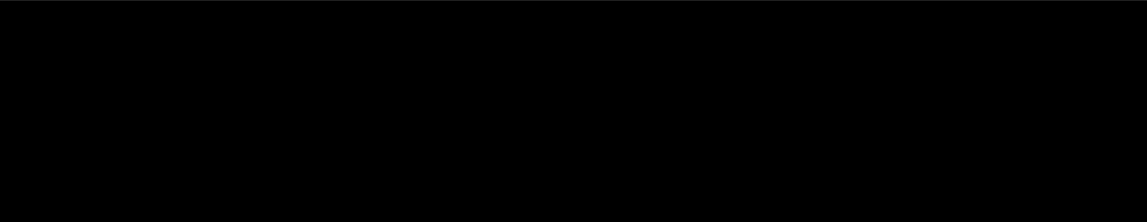
* The journal China Reconstructs is available in the *
