MEMORANDUM FOR: Chief, Liaison Division

SUBJECT : Downgrading of FDD's CTS and SIR Publications.

1. [redacted], FDD advised me on 24 January 1958 that the monthly Consolidated Translations Survey (CTS) and the semi-monthly Scientific Information Report (SIR) had both been downgraded to "Unclassified" so that copies may be given wider dissemination.
2. He requested that we make a survey of non-recipients to determine any additional dissemination requirements. He advised that the "Liaison Division" had instructed him to get such information from the Document Division.
