25X1 8. [redacted] Talked with Rose Blandford, House Armed Services Committee staff, on the question of a meeting with the Agency and he indicated the possibility of a meeting on Thursday, 5 August. He stated he would advise further. I also inquired whether Mr. Rivers was going on the floor soon with a statement on the Agency. Mr. Blandford stated he had not yet had a chance to discuss the prepared material on this with the Chairman but that he would do so in the near future.

25X1 9. [redacted] Talked with Jim Gehrig, Acting Staff Director, Senate Aeronautical and Space Sciences Committee, who indicated that the briefing on Monday of Senators Anderson, Smith, Symington and Magnuson was considered by all of the members as an excellent briefing and it particularly conveyed new information to Symington and Magnuson. Mr. Gehrig also stated that the Agency need have no concern in connection with the security reminder which Dr. Whoolen gave the Committee, that all understood the need for it and he had discussed it in particular with Senator Symington.
