1. (Unclassified - GLC) [redacted], Executive Officer to General Alva Fitch, Deputy Director of DIA, called to say that, acting for General Carroll, General Fitch had agreed to appear before the Inter-American Affairs Subcommittee of House Foreign Affairs (Selden) this Thursday. The subject of the briefing will be Communism in Cuba and Latin America. [redacted] said the General was interested in knowing whether Mr. McCone had appeared before this Subcommittee and, if so, whether a copy of his statement was available. I advised him that although the Director had been approached by Selden concerning an appearance, the Director had not appeared before the Subcommittee and we did not anticipate that he would, therefore, there was no statement. [redacted] thanked me for this information and closed by asking us if we would be in touch with him in the event the Director does make any appearances before this group. I told him we would be glad to do so.

2. [redacted] At the request of George Murphy, Joint Committee on Atomic Energy staff, arrangements have been made for Mr. Murphy and Mr. Kimmel, his document clerk, to bring a quantity of classified waste to the Agency under AEC guard for destruction in the CIA incinerator.

3. [redacted] Mr. William Woodruff on the staff of Senate Appropriations called to see if the transcript of the Director's appearance before Senate Armed Services and the Defense Subcommittee of Senate Appropriations could be made available this afternoon and for the next three days while Secretary McNamara is testifying. Arrangements have been made to send the transcript up each day and return to the Agency for overnight storage.
