**SUBJECT: DCI Briefing of Senate Armed Services
Committee and Defense Subcommittee
of the Senate Appropriations Committee**

1. I have made it a point to talk with several members of the Senate Armed Services Committee and of the Senate Defense Appropriations Subcommittee regarding the Director's briefing on 11 January 1965. I have also discussed the briefing with a number of the staff members who were present.
