25X1 1. [redacted] Called Mr. Derringer of the Department of Justice to inquire as to the status of their report on the revised Rodino bill (H.R. 14545) for the relief of employees of RFE and Radio Liberty. Mr. Derringer said the report had been signed and gone forward to the BOB this morning.

25X1 2. [redacted] Called Mr. Meek in the office of Representative Henry B. Gonzalez (D.-Tex.) relative to the [redacted] case and informed him that the file is now under review and that he should have a response within a few days.
