OPERATION TO INCLUDE A SHORT TOUR THROUGH THE COMMAND POST, AND INFORMATION ON THE INTRA-THEATER AIRLIFT SITUATION IN SOUTH VIETNAM. A VERY SHORT BRIEFING ON THE SEARCH AND RESCUE MISSION IS ALSO DESIRED AT MAC. TO COMPLETE THE TWO HOUR BRIEFING AT MAC, THE SUBCOMMITTEE WOULD APPRECIATE RECEIVING ANY OTHER INFORMATION MAC WOULD DESIRE TO PRESENT TO THE SUBCOMMITTEE.

SOME OF THE MEMBERS MAY DESIRE TO BE PICKED UP AT TRAVIS AFB AND A SCHEDULED STOP HAS BEEN SHOWN IN THE ITINERARY; HOWEVER, IF THE MEMBERS CHOOSE INSTEAD TO JOIN THE AIRCRAFT AT SCOTT OR ANDREWS, TRAVIS AFB WILL BE OVERFLOWN TO ARRIVE HICKAM DIRECT FROM SCOTT AFB.

ON 11 JANUARY THE SUBCOMMITTEE DESIRES BRIEFINGS FROM CINCPAC AND PACAF. THE PACAF BRIEFINGS SHOULD EMPHASIZE THE AIRLIFT SITUATION AND THE SEARCH AND RESCUE MISSION IN SEA.

AT KWAJALEIN, SUBCOMMITTEE REQUESTS LUNCH AND SHORT TOUR OF ISLAND, TOGETHER WITH A BRIEFING ON THE ABM AND ICBM TEST PROGRAM AT THAT FACILITY. TIME ON THE GROUND KWAJALEIN IS REQUESTED TO BE NO LONGER THAN TWO HOURS.
