4. [REDACTED] On instructions from Mr. McManus, I handcarried to Senator Frank J. Lausche's secretary a number of press items concerning Senator Stephen Young's remarks about CIA "atrocities" in Vietnam. Included were Senator Young's original statement and retraction, the ticker containing the Agency's denial of the Young charge and several selected Moscow Radio broadcasts playing up the Young allegations.
