25X1 4. [redacted] Talked further with Mrs. Nancy Pigman, in the office of Senator Leverett Saltonstall, on the draft newsletter she is preparing. She expects to have a clean draft at 10:30 tomorrow morning at which time we will take a further look at it. She agreed to accept several suggestions which I made on the existing draft.

25X1 5. [redacted] Delivered to William Darden, Senate Armed Services Committee staff. [redacted] Darden was very glad to have this statement and said he hoped to show it to the Chairman this afternoon.

25X1 6. [redacted] Delivered to Robert Michaels, House Appropriations Committee staff, [redacted] Michaels doubted that he would have an opportunity to bring this to the Chairman's attention immediately but was pleased to have it in the event questions should be raised on it.
