- 1. In February the DDCI directed that the DD/S&T undertake, in cooperation with the Executive Director-Comptroller, a manpower audit of the Office of Special Activities. The understanding was that any reductions achieved could be utilized by me to meet critical manpower requirements of this Directorate.

2. The Office of Special Activities Manpower Audit has been completed and the Task Force recommended a reduction of positions in the Table of Organization for OSA. I have reviewed these recommendations on an individual case-by-case basis with the Director of the Office of Special Activities, and we agree that these reductions will not seriously affect OSA's capability to carry out its assigned responsibilities. Therefore, I have approved the Task Force recommendations and am submitting two copies of the Task Force report herewith.
