MEMORANDUM FOR: Executive Officer/DEEST

SUBJECT : Listing of Personnel Engaged in the Development of Exploitation Equipment

REFERENCE : IAD/OSS- 100/66, ORD 1074/66

1. You requested an Office of Security position on the question of staffers being placed on lists and guidelines to employ in making a determination that such listing is permissible.

2. Security generally asks three questions and then determines each case on an individual basis:

a) What are the contents of the list, i.e., name, background, employer, etc.

b) Will the list be classified?

c) What will be the dissemination?

3. I posed these questions to [redacted] /MPIC [redacted] was out of town) who stated that the list in question carries a Confidential classification and would be disseminated only to the members of the COPE Committee. Its purpose was to promote better communications in order to facilitate problem solving. The general practice is to list an Office head rather than all the technically qualified individuals within an Office.

4. I also called Central Cover Staff and was told that [redacted] is under full cover and can not be listed as a CIA employee. There was no objection to the listing of [redacted]

5. I suggest you approve my returning these references to [redacted] order for him to remove [redacted] from the ORD response while at the same
