1. On Thursday, 10 March 1966, I interviewed Subject with regard to his difficulties in acquiring classified documents from the [REDACTED]. I advised [REDACTED] the purpose of the interview was to review the situation for my benefit, and to let him know that his course of action had entailed official correspondence between various components of the intelligence community which would not have been necessary if he had followed accepted procedures.

2. [REDACTED] was completely cooperative during the interview. He indicated he had only contacted [REDACTED] after representatives of the OCE Liaison Staff specifically suggested he do so. [REDACTED] said he had made a substantial effort to obtain this material through official channels but seemed to have hit a brick wall with OCE Liaison. When OCE suggested he go direct, he did so. [REDACTED] indicated it was his understanding that some of the difficulty involved around the recipient of his request at [REDACTED] believing his name was [REDACTED].

3. As matters now stand [REDACTED] has been apprized that he was out of order to contact [REDACTED] directly. He was directed to obtain security guidance in these matters as similar situations occur in the future. It should be added, as a matter for the official record in this case, that [REDACTED] believes he was following instructions from the OCE Liaison Staff. It should also be added that [REDACTED] has yet to receive the documents he first requested in September 1965. I suggested that he not pursue the search any further.
