More Reds Defecting

Allen Dulles Declares Ex-Communists Are Being Questioned

CHICAGO (INS) — Allen Dulles, director of the super-secret Central Intelligence Agency, says "many more high level" Red agents have defected to the West and are now being questioned by the United States.

He disclosed in a Chicago speech last night that public announcements of these new defections "are being held back for the time being so that we can delve more deeply into each case."

Dulles said the reason for continued secrecy at this time is to piece together information of the Communist intelligence apparatus.

He did not further describe these "high level defections" or reveal when they had taken place or where the CIA was holding the former Red agents.

Key Police Agents

He said the cases involved key Red "secret police agents" and indicated the men and disclosures would rank in importance with recent defections of MVD officers in Germany, Poland and Australia.

While Dulles mentioned no names, it was apparent he was referring to secret police chief Jozef Swiatlo of Poland and Russian MVD agent Vladimir Petrov and Capt. Nikolai Khokhlov.

All three had fled to the west, seeking political asylum. Through Swiatlo the No. 1 Field mystery was unraveled, through Petrov the Red underground in Australia was uncovered and through Khokhlov the inner workings of a Red assassins' ring were exposed.

Seldom Talks Publicly

Dulles, whose sensitive position as head of America's principal espionage agency has made him an infrequent public speaker, chose a private dinner of the University of Chicago Law School alumni to describe Communist espionage techniques and CIA counter-measures.

He stressed he was outlining Red subversive methods to show how a "free society" like ours which is based on respect for the laws can deal with the subversive threat of international commu-
