'Parade' Will Carry Appraisal of Russia

For the first time, Allen W. Dulles, director of the Central Intelligence Agency, will have a signed article published tomorrow. Titled "Let's Look at Russia Honestly," it will appear in Parade magazine, supplement to The Roanoke Times' Sunday edition.

With Dulles and the CIA figuring prominently in news of the day, his appraisal of the Reds comes with apt timing by the editors of Parade magazine.

Even though he warns of the Reds' threat to world peace with their technological advances, Dulles says there is a potent force working in behalf of the free nations which oppose Russia and communism.
