**2 BILLION A YEAR  
REPORTED SPENT  
ON RED FRONTS**

WASHINGTON, Jan. 30 (AP)

Allen Dulles, director of the Central Intelligence Agency, said yesterday that international Communism is spending an estimated two billion dollars a year on "front" organizations in free world countries.

"They appreciate the value of these propagandist movements and organizations and they are willing to pay dearly for them," Dulles said.

Dulles addressed the Women's Forum on National Security, sponsored by a dozen women's national patriotic organizations. He cited a list of international organizations which he said are among the most important of those supported by world Communism and said they are more active in other countries than in the United States.

Among them he listed the Women's International Democratic Federation which he said costs the Communists an estimated \$6,000,000 a year alone.

"Contrast this expenditure with the fact that the Soviet has not to this date contributed a penny to the United Nations International Children's Emergency Fund," he said.
