(TEXT) JAKARTA--~~"WE ARE SUSPICIOUS AT THE ARRIVAL OF ALLEN DILLES~~
AND CONDEMN THE MILITARY MANEUVERS OF THE SEATO POWERS SINCE THEY
HAPPENED AT A TIME WHEN INDONESIA IS CONCENTRATING IN HER ECONOMIC
CONSTRUCTION," "BINTANG TIMUR" DECLARED TODAY.

THE CHIEF OF THE AMERICAN INTELLIGENCE SERVICE DID NOT COME FOR
SIGHTSEEING AND THE MANEUVERS OF SEATO WERE NOT HELD WITHOUT
ULTERIOR PURPOSES, THE PAPER POINTED OUT. THESE SUSPICIOUS
ACTIVITIES SHOWED TRACES OF INTIMIDATION UPON WHICH INDONESIA
MUST KEEP A WATCHFUL EYE, THE PAPER WROTE.

MILITARY MANEUVER IN THIS AREA WOULD CERTAINLY DISTURB THE LIFE
OF THE INDONESIAN PEOPLE AND COMMERCIAL NAVIGATION, THE PAPER
