# The Rockefeller Stake in the Elections

JOHN D. ROCKEFELLER, the 82-year-old banker and Oil King, has an immense stake in a Republican victory in November. So have his five sons, who manage the family's billions. For President Eisenhower's foreign policy is directed by two Rockefeller agents—the Dulles brothers. And that control fattens the world's richest family. . . . One also finds Rockefeller men in the Treasury, where the tax deals are made. And in Defense, where billions are spent for oil and munitions. But the family's tightest grip is in the foreign policy field. For much of Rockefeller's wealth lies in semi-colonial lands overseas. And milking

these lands requires U. S. government help. And now we come to the two Dulles brothers, who operate the foreign policy machine:

JOHN FOSTER DULLES, the elder, is Secretary of State. His job is to pressure foreign rulers to follow Wall Street's will. And he has an army of striped pants diplomats and a budget of 300 million dollars to help him.

ALLAN WELSH DULLES, the younger, is Chief of the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA). His job is to spy and to overthrow governments that stand in the Rockefeller way. He has an army of 10,000 to 30,000 spies and saboteurs to help him. And a budget that runs from several hundred millions to one billion dollars a year (U. S. News, July 16, 1954). The exact amount is a guess, for CIA expenditures are hidden.

EACH brother is a Rockefeller man. John Foster Dulles, the diplomat, was chairman of the Rockefeller representative in the banking

and nickel mining world.

And Allan Welsh Dulles, the Spy Master and Sabotage Chief, was a Rockefeller banker. He was a director of the J. Henry Schroder Banking Corp., that helped the Nazis so much. He sat on the Schroder board for 15 years while the bank was helping the rearmament of Germany and was aiding the industrialists behind Hitler.

Allan Dulles' bank is still in the Rockefeller camp. The stock ownership of the bank itself is secret. But records show that 42 percent of the stock of the Schroder-Rockefeller Co., the bank's securities affiliate, is owned by Avery Rockefeller, a cousin of the five brothers.

**THE** two Rockefeller men time their plots together, although their offices are nearly a mile apart. John Foster Dulles, the diplomat, is housed in the antique State Department Building near the White House. And Allan Dulles, meets his wiretappers, bribers, bombers of Socialist bridges, and underground army officers in a red brick building behind a high steel fence, topped by barbed wire in the Foggy Bottom Section of Washington.

The joint timing of the brothers' plots was seen in two bloody insurrections against liberal governments since Eisenhower came in.

The first coup was in Iran in August 1953. Premier Mossadegh had nationalized the oil fields and refineries of the Anglo Iranian Oil Co. This deed was worse than murder in the Rockefeller code. So the Dulles brothers got busy.

Allan Dulles' role was more important. For the CIA actually planned the bloody uprising, according to inspired magazine articles. In fact Allan Dulles went to Switzerland to meet the Shah's sister, Princess Ashraf, a few days before the coup, to work out final details.

Brother John Foster Dulles was also in the bloody plot. So was Herbert Hoover, Jr., the present Under Secretary of State. Hoover is an oil man himself, and close to the Rockefeller interests. And he worked out the deal that gave 40 percent of the (British) Anglo Iranian properties to the American oil trusts.

But the actual coup was described as a CIA job.

And if Dulles wasn't happy at the executions that followed the coup, then no one could guess it.

**THE** next CIA coup was in Guatemala, where the progressive Arbenz government had been distributing land to the people. And American investors in all Latin America were alarmed—the Rockefeller oil men in Venezuela among them. The Guatemalan example might spread. Oil as well as land might be taken back by the people. And the Dulles brothers got busy again.

Allan Dulles had the bigger job, however. For this was hot war—not cold. And Castillo Armas, the discredited adventurer, was supplied with American weapons. Corrupt army officers in Guatemala were bribed. And executions of patriotic Guatemalans finished the deal.

This job is credited to Allan Dulles, in magazine articles, which bear the earmarks of CIA collaboration.

**THE** next job might have been in Egypt. For an inspired article in the Saturday Evening Post (Nov. 6, 1954) says CIA operatives are busy there.

The Dulles brothers, meanwhile, are using their weapons against the Socialist lands, and their 900 million people.

They make no secret of this. And Allan Dulles' sabotage squads blow up Socialist bridges, while his brother talks of the "liberation" of the Socialist lands.

The CIA boasts of these bombing jobs. One can find these boasts recorded in the inspired magazine articles, which glorify the Spy Master. That Nov. 6, 1954, Saturday Evening Post article tells of a typical demolition job by CIA saboteurs. In one country which they did not name, the writers said:

"... a CIA agent dispatched a band of saboteurs to a trestle on the main Red rail supply line. Under cover of night the underground leader attached a small piece of gooey plastic explosive to a main timber as simply as a school-girl would stick her chewing gum to the underside of the seat at the moving pictures. The next day the Red-controlled press called for the arrest of 'foreign' and criminal elements responsible for attacks against the state in blowing up another 'people's bridge.'"

This article was largely based on

interviews with intelligence leaders, the authors say.

**THE** CIA has its Labor Department too. For CIA funds are often spent on non-Communist labor leaders in other lands, the Saturday Evening Post reports. The money is used to promote more vigorous anti-Communist action. The U. S. News tells a similar story.

CIA agents also try to stimulate labor unrest in the Socialist lands. The Saturday Evening Post boasts that a slow down in an unnamed factory in one of the Socialist countries was a CIA job. Such results seem feeble, however.

More serious is demolition and murder. The U. S. News of April 9, 1948, said the tactic of "assassination" of key Communist leaders was being considered. This article

was written before the CIA got under way. But the story cannot be easily dismissed. For The U. S. News—which is published by David Lawrence—is close to the most reactionary circles in Washington.

The Rockefeller agents hate the Soviet Union most of all. They hate it because it is helping the downtrodden peoples of Asia and Africa to stand on their own feet. These people can be independent of American and British imperialism with socialist aid.
