Reds' 'Peaceful' Tactics Explained by Allen Dulles

WASHINGTON, Sept. 1. Allen W. Dulles, director of the Zentral Intelligence Agency, sees 'serious" parliamentary situaions posed in Italy, France and ndonesia by the Soviet Union n its new "peaceful" penetraion tactics.

The House Committee on Unmerican Activities tonight reeased a statement given it arlier this week by Mr. Dulles in which he noted that the Kremin, checkmated in the use of rute force by NATO and other ree world alliances, is seeking gain to use more peaceful neans of gaining control in free ountries.

He said there is no cause for oo great alarm, but warned that in several countries these enetrations are serious." He ontinued:
