Allan Dulles Called Revolt Mastermind

BERLIN, July 1 (UP)—An official Communist newspaper charged from behind the Iron Curtain today that U. S. Central Intelligence Agency chief Allan Dulles helped mastermind the Poznan revolt.

The accusation came as reports from Poznan said the Polish city returned to near normal today under the constant watchfulness of heavily-armed Communist troop patrols and tanks.

There was no sound of gunfire for the first time in four days.

People shopped again, went to church, mourned their dead and awaited the fate of 300 arrested persons undergoing questioning by Communist security authorities.

DULLES INVOLVED

The East German Communist party newspaper "Neues Deutschland" claimed there was "no doubt" Allan Dulles "participated in the planning" of the Poznan

worker rebellion which started Thursday.

"No wonder that Allan's brother, Secretary of State John Foster Dulles, was able to give a well thought out statement for the American State Department on the happenings in Poznan almost before any news came out of Poznan", the Red organ said.

This was the latest blast in a campaign by all party organs behind the Iron Curtain to blame the revolt on foreign agents instead of on the internal unrests that the rioters proclaimed.

DISCIPLINE EXERTED
