(TEXT) JAKARTA -- "HARIAN RAKJAT" TODAY DISCLOSES THE RECKLESS INTERVENTION OF THE UNITED STATES IN THE INTERNAL AFFAIRS OF INDONESIA. THE PAPER REPORTS THAT, DURING THE PERIOD OF THE SUCCESS OF SIMBOLOV'S REBELLION, PLANES UNDER THE COMMAND OF CHENNAULT LANDED IN NORTH SUMATRA. THOSE WHO CAME WITH THE PLANES SAID THAT IN ORDER TO OBTAIN AID, SIMBOLON SHOULD AT LEAST AFFORD THE SAME PROTECTION TO AMERICAN PETROLEUM INTERESTS IN NORTH SUMATRA AS WERE AFFORDED TO HOLLAND.

THE SAME PAPER ALSO NOTES THAT HUGH CUMMINGS, AMERICAN AMBASSADOR TO INDONESIA, HAS INFORMED PREMIER ALI THAT IT IS POSSIBLE FOR THE UNITED STATES TO RECOGNIZE THE DE FACTO REGIME OF SIMBOLON.

"HARIAN RAKJAT" POINTS OUT THAT THE ARMY CLIQUE WHICH REBELLED HAD ALREADY ESTABLISHED RELATIONS WITH THE UNITED STATES WHEN PLANNING THE COUP D'ETAT. THE PAPER CALLS ON EVERYONE NOT TO FORGET THE TALKS BETWEEN ALLEN DULLES AND LUBIS.

THE DAILY FURTHER QUOTES A "U.P." DISPATCH OF YESTERDAY WHICH REPORTED THAT THE AMERICAN OFFICIALS IN WASHINGTON ALSO ADVOCATED ALLOWING HATTA TO LEAD THE INDONESIAN CABINET.

A MEMBER OF THE FOREIGN AFFAIRS COMMITTEE OF THE INDONESIAN PARLIAMENT TOLD A REPORTER OF "HARIAN RAKJAT" THAT SUCH AN ATTITUDE ON THE PART OF THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTES RECKLESS INTERVENTION IN THE INTERNAL AFFAIRS OF INDONESIA, AND THAT HE WOULD PRESENT THE QUESTION TO THE FOREIGN AFFAIRS COMMITTEE FOR DISCUSSION.

THE EDITORIAL TO TODAY'S "HARIAN RAKJAT" POINTS OUT THAT THE INTERVENTION OF THE AMERICAN IMPERIALISTS IN THE INTERNAL AFFAIRS OF INDONESIA HAS BECOME EXTREMELY EVIDENT. THE FACT IS THAT THE UNITED STATES NOT ONLY STANDS ON THE SIDE OF HOLLAND IN WEST IRAN BUT ALSO ON THE SIDE OF LUBIS IN JAKARTA AND SIMBOLON IN NORTH SUMATRA.

THE EDITORIAL SAYS THAT THE VERY MINIMUM IT EXPECTS THE GOVERNMENT TO DO IS TO LODGE A PROTEST WITH THE PRESENT U.S. GOVERNMENT, OR THE INDONESIAN GOVERNMENT CANNOT CLAIM ANY SELF-RESPECT WORTH MENTIONING.

THE EDITORIAL ASSERTS THAT THE ATTITUDE OF LUBIS, NASUTION, THE SOCIALIST PARTY, SIMBOLON, AND HATTA HAS MORE AND MORE INDICATED THEIR RELATIONS AND THEIR COMMON STAND WITH THE IMPERIALISTS.

IT IS VERY APPARENT, THE EDITORIAL CONCLUDES, THAT THE PRESENT QUESTION IS NOT MERELY AN INTERNAL ONE; IT IS A QUESTION OF SURRENDER TO OR REVOLT AGAINST THE WISHES OF FOREIGN IMPERIALISTS. IN ORDER TO ACHIEVE INDEPENDENCE, THERE SHOULD BE NO COMPROMISE WITH COLONIALISM.
