DAVID BRINKLEY: "Senator Long of Louisiana says he's always thought there were two rifle men in Dallas, but he offers no evidence. Governor Connally of Texas does not believe he and Kennedy were hit by the same bullet.

"But, the Commission members say again they have seen no new evidence worth investigating. One saying this, is Allen Dulles, former head of the CIA, and later a member of the Commission."
