Congo Consul To Appear Sunday

U.S. Consul Michael P. E. Hoyt, recently rescued from Congo rebels at Stanleyville, will be the featured speaker Dec. 6, at the Sunday Evening Forum, in the University of Arizona auditorium, at 8 p.m.

Consul Hoyt had been a prisoner of Congolese rebels for three months when he and four other U.S. Consulate staff members were rescued last week by a U.S.-Belgian paratroop operation.

Mrs. Hoyt has been residing in Tucson with the Hoyt's four children, since their evacuation from the Congo before Consul Hoyt's capture. The family has since joined the consul in Washington, D.C.

Samuel C. McMillan, University of Arizona vice president, will introduce Consul Hoyt to the audience.

Consul Hoyt will tell of his capture and events in the Congo leading to the rebellion. Allen W. Dulles, former Central Intelligence Agency chief, originally scheduled to speak on Dec. 6, will not appear.
