OCI has Couriers assigned from the Central Courier Service making internal delivereies-also shown in attached schedule.

OCI says outside couriers the generally the contents of documents they are carrying but that they are not permitted to answer specific on general guestions concerning a subject of intelligence matter. They are instructed to answer that they don't know but will see that the requestor is furnished the information.

OCI says they no longer make the run to AEC Germantown, but have arranged to meet an AEC courier who rides a bus to 1717 H Street from Germantown. Does this indicate that much of the other OCI material can be delivered through normal channels and can go at a slower speed than the Special or Hand-Carry method.
