5. [redacted] Talked with Senator Symington's office, Miss Nelson, advising her that [redacted] will arrive in Honolulu tomorrow on PanAm flight #2. This information will be communicated to the Senator there.

[redacted] Talked with Mr. Blandford, House Armed Services Committee staff, who indicated he probably would wish to review the [redacted] ABM situation with me tomorrow morning.
