SUBJECT : CIA Contribution to Special Middle

East Study

1. One of CIA's commitments to your study is a projection of economic trends in the area over the next ten years. It was promised on a tentative basis for 15 June, with an absolute deadline of 30 June.

- 2. Due to the Arab-Israeli war and its aftermath, levies on the Office of Research and Reports for economic reporting have been heavy. In addition, the special NSC committee studying the Arab-Israeli problem has demanded on the highest priority a number of special economic studies.
- 3. These demands have taken the entire time of the relatively small group of ORR economists dealing with this area, and we have had no choice but to assign a lower priority to other projects.
- 4. I regret, therefore, that ORR will not be able to furnish its annex until 14 July.
