1. The suggestions made in referenced memorandum are greatly appreciated. In the future, the appendices entitled "Gaps in Intelligence" attached to Top Secret Codeword studies prepared by the Office of Research and Reports will be reviewed to assure that non-codeword requirements have been or will be submitted through regular collateral channels to RM and other collection facilities. It is believed that the consistent utilization of the existing mechanism for forwarding non-codeword statements of intelligence gaps will eliminate the possibility of ROM receiving duplicate collection requirements.

2. Collection requirements which cannot be sanitized will continue to be forwarded to your office for appropriate action.

It is suggested that the appendices on "Gaps in Intelligence" attached to Top Secret Codeword studies by the Office of Research and Reports would be made usable in the clandestine intelligence collection program if such sections bore a non-codeword classification. For example, SC No. 05917/56, New Construction in the Chemical Industry of the USSR, contains an Appendix C on "Gaps in Intelligence" in which some of the comments specifying information needed might be worded in such a way as to fit into a non-codeword classification.
- 2. It is therefore recommended that consideration be given to the possibility of issuing, whenever possible, non-codeword "Gaps in Intelligence" supplements to future studies of this kind.
