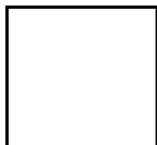
2. If you have no objection, I will pass one of the copies on to Dick. I am sure that one or more will be relatively unmarked.

3. Dick again raised the question of DD/S&T participation with TSD in briefing key DDP operational people on R&D program plans where both TSD and ORD, etc., have a portion of the action. I told Dick that I had mentioned this to you after we had discussed the over-all audio planning approach a couple of weeks ago, and suggested that he obtain your reaction directly since I wasn't sure what you would like to do about this. What [redacted] now has in mind, apparently, is a review group [redacted] for about 3 days in February. The composition of the group would be approximately one-third DDP operational types, one-third TSD, and one-third DD/S&T - primarily ORD. Composite ORD-TSD planning for the next FY would be informally presented for DDP comment. I think this would be very worthwhile if the rivalry level can be kept at a reasonable level.
