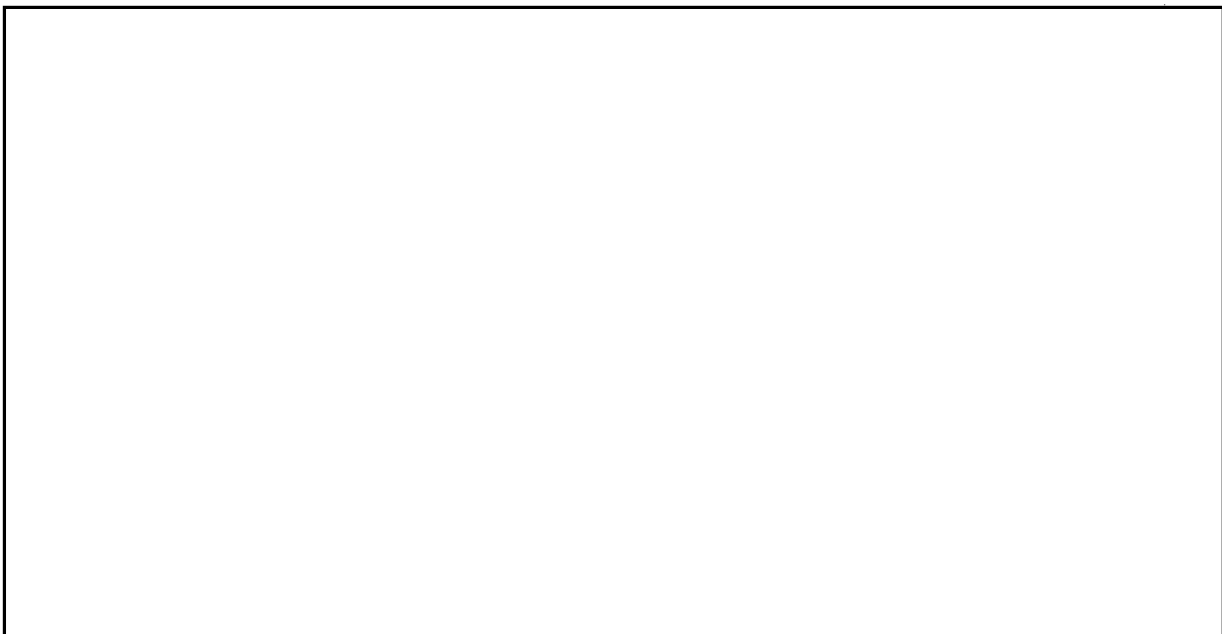

1. (Unclassified - GIC) William Lowell, Senate International Security Subcommittee staff, called to say that the Subcommittee will receive page proofs of Mr. Helms' testimony on Saturday and the final prints on Monday. Release of his testimony is tentatively scheduled for Friday, 16 June. Arrangements have been made for Mr. Don Pratt and me to review the page proofs Saturday morning.

2. (Unclassified - GIC) Mr. McAfee, State Department, called to check again on any action we have taken on S.J. Res. 11, Senator McCarthy's Joint Committee bill. I advised McAfee that we expect to be in touch with the White House on this today and that we would be in touch with him in the very near future. I also advised McAfee that USIA had submitted a draft report on this bill to the Bureau of the Budget.
