In 1963 a member of Grabowski's staff called to find out the nature of our activities in South Viet Nam. Grabowski, in early 1965, agreed in an editorial with Senator Dodd's statement on Viet Nam. And in early 1966 he introduced a Resolution supporting the President's efforts to limit the spread of nuclear weapons.
