I have not forgotten our recent conversation and thought in line with some of your comments that you might be interested in items which appeared recently in the CONGRESSIONAL RECORD. One is the debate on the floor of the Senate discussing Senator McCarthy's proposal for a new Senate committee composed of members of Armed Services, Appropriations, and Foreign Relations. Subsequent to this debate there was much background discussion, and the matter is now dormant but the comments of the individual senators are, I believe, quite interesting. The two other items are remarks by Senator Symington and Senator Lausche concerning some of the various allegations against the Agency. Also enclosed is a copy of Senator Saltonstall's newsletter which may be of interest.

This is some of the strongest congressional support we have had in some time and may be the result of reactions akin to your own. I do not have any concrete ideas on how material of this sort can best be used, but feel free to do with it as you please.
