1. In reading the report referenced above, it was noted in paragraph 3.b(1), TAB 3 (DCO Annex), that expected to find many salvable periscope components in the nose of #126 when access to the hangar was granted. I feel that salvaged parts from aircraft wrecks, albeit intended for use only in training, bench models, mock-ups, etc., might in time find their way back into the spares inventory. To permit such a possibility to exist would be, in my opinion, most unwise, and would further compound "Murphy's" law.

2. I call this to your attention to see if steps can be taken to prevent use of salvage parts from aircraft wrecks, however serviceable they may be, without a positive system of marking or identification to preclude re-entry into the spares inventory.
