1. [Redacted] gave the Executive Committee a briefing on the KY-3 program. It was extremely good. The DCI requested consideration of the installation of KY-3's in the homes of the Deputy Directors. I asked Mr. [Redacted] to prepare a paper with all appropriate input on costs, etc., for the Executive Director.

2. The appointment of [Redacted] and Mr. [Redacted] was approved by Colonel White and myself. Security was notified.

3. [Redacted] is seriously ill and expected to die. Some publicity may result. I informed Mr. Helms. I requested Security to brief [Redacted] on the [Redacted] cases as he has never been briefed. I also noted that the Director has never been informed of these cases and at some appropriate time we should advise him of this situation.
