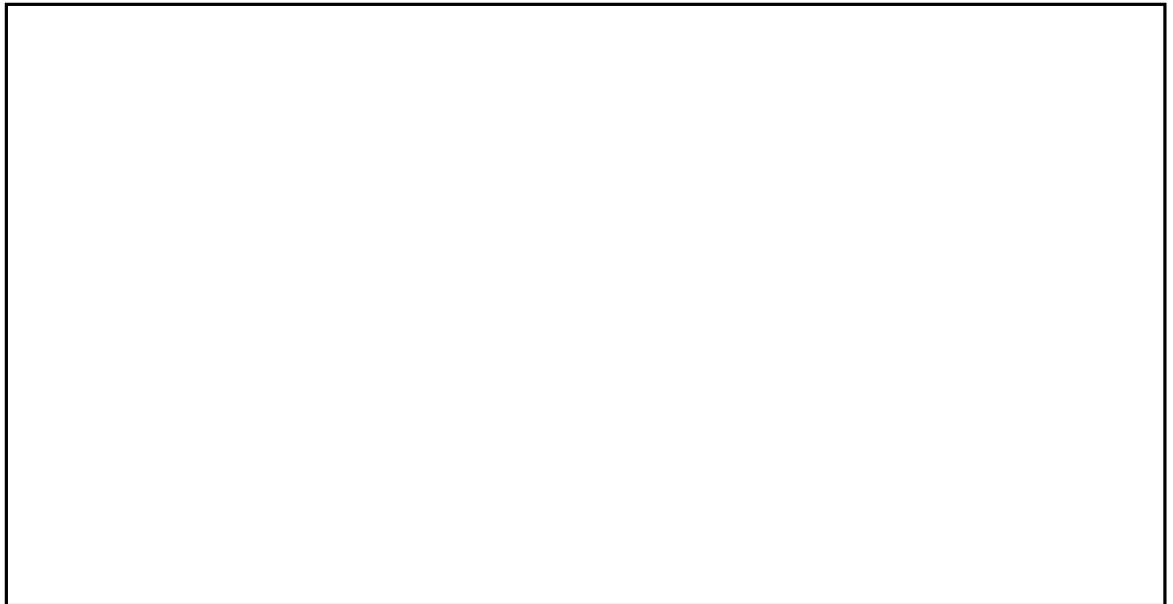

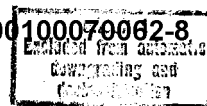

4. I briefed [redacted] the Deputy Chief of Support designee for [redacted]. He was somewhat overwhelmed, but I simply told him to join the club.

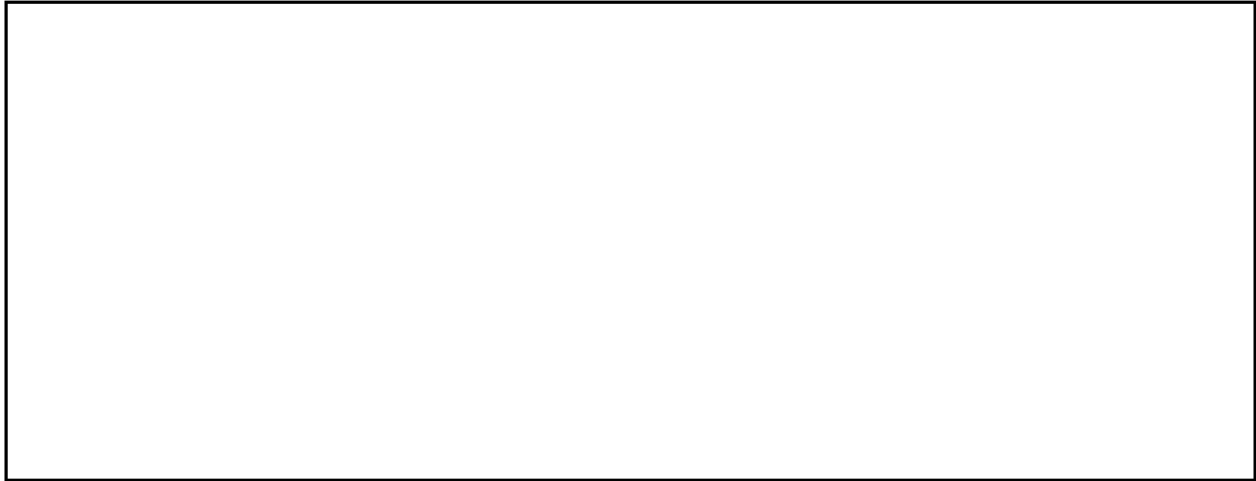
