## U.S. Dedicates Antisub Base

NASSAU, Bahamas (AP)—A new U.S. antisubmarine base was dedicated yesterday at Andros Island, 45 miles southwest of Nassau. Rear Adm. Norman J. Dustrup said it "surpass anything we know of in the entire world."

"The Communist bloc today has more than 400 submarines in operation, a fleet eight times larger than Hitler's," he told 350 who gathered for the ceremony.

"That's why antisubmarine warfare improvement is one of the top priority missions of the U.S. Navy and the British Admiralty."

The \$130-million base, called the Atlantic Undersea Testing and Evaluation Center, will experiment with new methods of seeking and destroying enemy submarines.
