CIA Financed Franco's Foes, Paper Says

MADRID, May 9—The Madrid evening newspaper Pueblo tonight published a report alleging that the United States Central Intelligence Agency poured over \$1 million into Spain's banned Basque Separatist Movement between 1950 and 1956.

It claimed the CIA paid \$1,016,000 during the period into the bank account of exiled Spanish Prof. Jesus de Galindez, said to be leader of a Basque movement.

[Spanish Civil War refugee de Galindez went to the Santo Domingo after leaving Spain. He later became an outstanding critic of Dominican Dictator Rafael Trujillo, and vanished March 12, 1956 in New York City. Many believed that he was kidnaped and killed by Trujillo agents.]
