Bay of Pigs Exiles Ask Second Try

NEW YORK, June 5 (AP)

Veterans of the Cuban Bay of Pigs invasion formed a central organization today in hopes of mounting another invasion. They called for help from any source, including Cuba's former dictator Fulgencio Batista.

The veterans of the 1961 invasion that was crushed by Fidel Castro's troops formed a "Central Liberation Front," composed of a number of exile groups which hope to mount an invasion soon.

Some 150 veterans of the assault brigade which made that invasion were at a mass meeting at Manhattan Center attended by about 2000 persons.

One speaker, Waldo Carmona, representing the brigade in New York, charged the United States with indifference and said this country does not want to help to fight Castro.
