**Kerby Slated to Be
Dow Jones President**

At the March 15 meeting of directors of Dow Jones & Company, Bernard Kilgore will retire as president, a position he has filled for 20 years, and move up to chairman.

Mr. Kilgore said he will propose the election of William F. Kerby, now executive vicepresident, as president; Buren McCormack as executive vicepresident, and Robert Bottorff as general manager.

Dow Jones publishes the *Wall Street Journal*, the *National Observer* and *Barron's*. It also owns Dow Jones Books and operates the Dow Jones News Service.
