**LBJ Retains
Popularity in
Latest Count**

Despite continued criticism in certain quarters of the Administration's Vietnam policies, little marked change has occurred in public support for the way President Johnson is dealing with the war, and for the way he is handling the Vietnam situation.

Gallup Poll interviewers put this question to a cross-section sample of the population:

"Do you approve or disapprove of the way President Johnson is handling the situation in Vietnam?"
