Gallup Poll

Despite continued criticism of the Administration's Viet-Nam policies, little marked change has occurred in public support for the way President Johnson is dealing with the war, and for the way he is handling his overall job as Chief Executive.

Fifty-four per cent in the latest Gallup Poll approve of the way President Johnson is handling Viet Nam. Thirty-one per cent disapprove. The figures recorded last month were 56 per cent and 26 per cent.

Gallup Poll interviewers put this question to a cross-section sample of the population:

"Do you approve or disapprove of the way President Johnson is handling the situation in Viet Nam?"
