'Liaison for Americas'

**Radio Programs About Latin America Set**

Liaison for the Americas, a non-profit organization created to inform the United States about Latin American countries, will present the first of an 18-program series Thursday at 10:30 p.m. over the American University radio station WAMU-FM.

Liaison, working with all the Inter-American agencies, will provide each of the 19 countries in Latin America with the chance to have three or four programs a year on which they can speak for and about themselves.

The first program, which will be produced by American University, will be introduced by Sen. Hubert H. Humphrey (D., Minn.).

Some of the programs will be produced in Latin America and some by embassies here. will act as an agent for writers, musicians, artists and lecturers from Latin America.
