5 Firms Link Vote Reports

NEW YORK, March 30 (UPI)—Five major news organizations, which collaborated in collection and tabulation of the 1964 presidential election returns, have agreed to collaborate again in the collection and tabulation of votes in 1966 and 1968.

American Broadcasting Co., the Associated Press, Columbia Broadcasting System, National Broadcasting Co., Inc., and United Press International

al have formed the News Election Service (NES) to collect and distribute returns in all 50 states in 1966 and 1968 on contests for Governor, U.S. Senate and the U.S. House of Representatives, and in the 1968 presidential election. In both years a national tabulation center will be established. NES will furnish election

returns simultaneously to the broadcasting organizations and the wire services.
