WASHINGTON, MAY 10 (AP)-REP. ADAM CLAYTON POWELL, D-N.Y., SAID TODAY HE HAD RECEIVED UNVERIFIED INFORMATION THAT CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE AGENCY PERSONNEL WERE ASSOCIATED WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF PENNSYLVANIA AND MASSACHUSETTS INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY.

POWELL MADE THE ASSERTION IN ANNOUNCING AN INVESTIGATION BY THE STAFF OF THE HOUSE EDUCATION AND LABOR COMMITTEE, WHICH HE HEADS, OF CIA CONTACTS WITH MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY, PREVIOUSLY REPORTED.

HE SAID HIS SON, AN EMPLOYEE OF A TELEVISION NETWORK, HAD TOLD HIM THE INTELLIGENCE AGENCY HAD BEEN CONNECTED WITH AN MIT PROJECT.

"AND JUST TODAY," HE SAID, "I RECEIVED AN ANONYMOUS LETTER LISTING NAMES SAID TO BE OF CIA PEOPLE ON THE CAMPUS AND FACULTY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF PENNSYLVANIA."

POWELL SAID DR. EUNICE MATTHEW, EDUCATION CHIEF OF THE COMMITTEE WILL CONDUCT THE INQUIRY, BEGINNING AT ONCE. "I'M INTERESTED IN FINDING OUT WHETHER ANY FUNDS FROM THE HIGHER EDUCATION ACT ARE BEING PERVERTED TO ASSIST THE CIA," HE SAID.
