**R.C.A. Education Aide
Named Vice President**

The Radio Corporation of America announced here yesterday a change in the title of Dr. Carroll V. Newsom to vice president in charge of education from educational consultant.

Robert W. Sarnoff, president of R.C.A., said Dr. Newsom would be responsible for the development of the company's educational plans and programs and would coordinate its educational products and services.

Dr. Newsom was president of New York University from 1956 to 1962. He was president of Prentice-Hall, Inc., in 1964 and 1965 and became R.C.A.'s education consultant later that year.

He was elected a director of R.C.A. and its National Broadcasting Company subsidiary in 1961, and is also a director of Random House, Inc.
